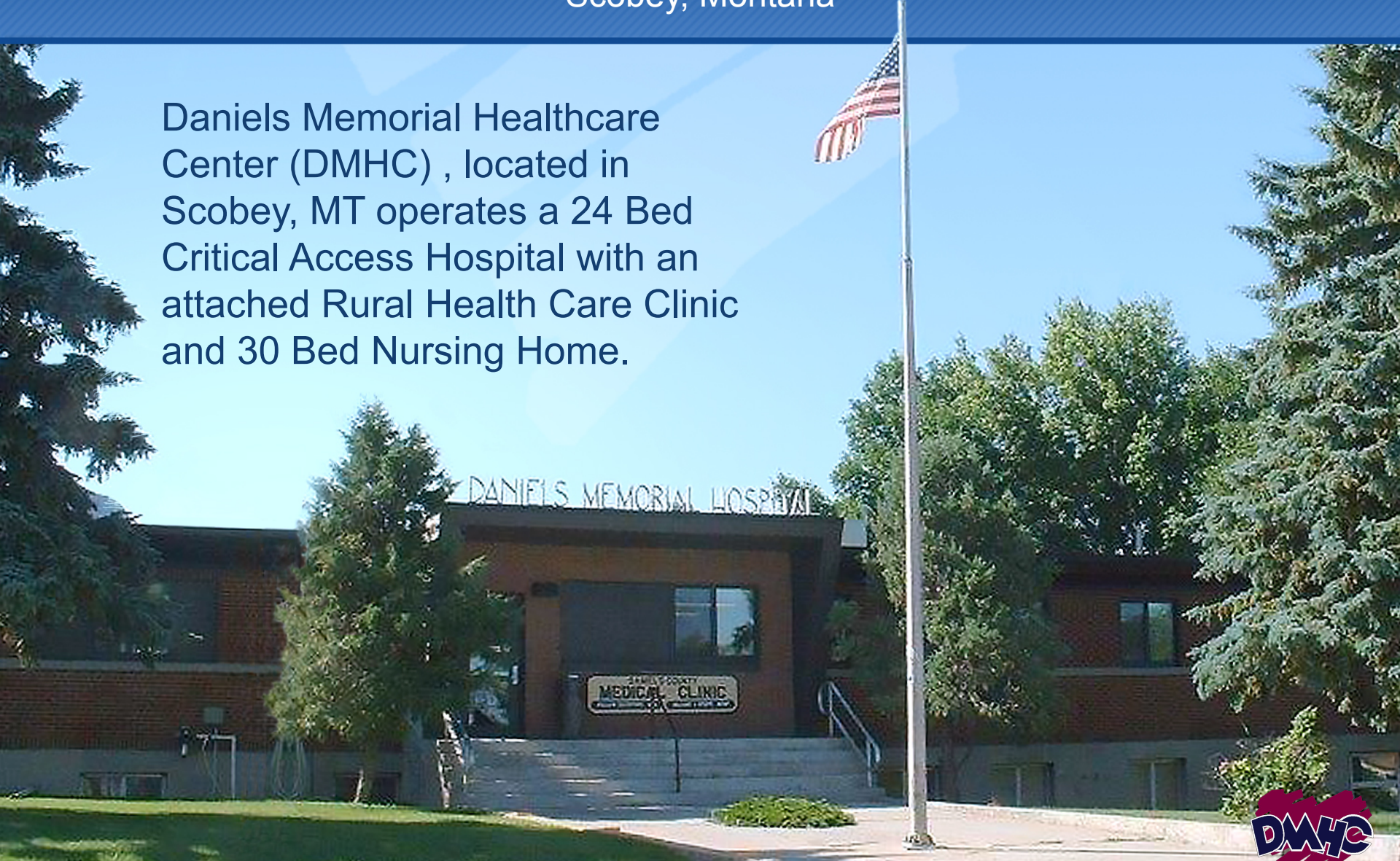


Daniels Memorial Healthcare Center

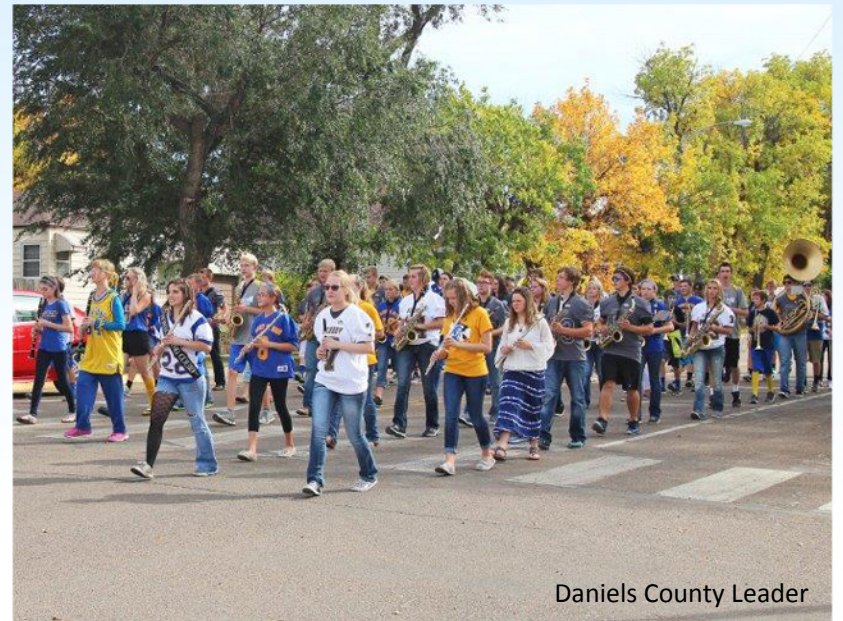
